



GETTING AROUND WSU

Campus shuttle

Wayne State University currently offers three complimentary campus shuttles that allow you to get from one side of campus to the other by simply showing your OneCard. The WSU shuttles are part of the Midtown Connection and have two transfer stops that allow you to transfer to the Henry Ford Hospital and Detroit Medical Center's shuttle systems. The main campus shuttle runs from 7 a.m. to 11 p.m. Monday through Friday during the fall and winter semesters. Service runs continuously in approximately 30-minute intervals. This shuttle is labeled "Main Campus Shuttle." The medical campus shuttle runs from 7 a.m. to 9 p.m. Monday through Friday during the fall and winter semesters, and 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Monday through Friday during the spring/summer semesters

with stops to MISB. Service runs continuously in 30-minute intervals. This shuttle is labeled "Medical Campus Shuttle."

The Mike Ilitch School of Business (MISB) shuttle runs from 8 a.m. to 11 p.m. Monday through Thursday and 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. on Friday during the fall and winter semesters. Service runs continuously in approximately 20-minute intervals. This shuttle is labeled "MISB Shuttle".

The shuttles do not operate on weekends, holidays and university closure days. To see the real-time location of the shuttles, use the WSU mobile app. For more details, visit parking.wayne.edu/
